Did you know that Centennial has a dedicated Resource Centre for students to get extra support with their academics? Here's what you should know:

- The Resource Center is open from 8:30am to 4:05pm every day, and until 5:15pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Offering extra support every morning before school, during class time, every day at lunch, and after school twice a week.
- The Resource Center supports over 150 students per week.
- The resource team has a combined total of over 350 years of teaching experience.
- The RC has a resource teacher available every class period.
- The RC also has an in-class support staffer available almost every class period.
- Every 9-day cycle, 170 hours of help is given to the students by our resource teacher team.
