Subject: Visual Arts

Level: Secondary 1-5

COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES

Throughout their visual arts studies, students learn to use different types of knowledge acquired in the classroom and through their cultural experiences to *create their own personal images or images targeting a specific public* and containing a *visual message*. They acquire the skills necessary to exercise critical judgment when *appreciating various types of images* and learn to use correct language and the appropriate terminology to formulate this appreciation.

Transforming gestures will be explored through use of the following techniques: drawing, painting, collage, engraving, printing, modeling, shaping, and assembling.
